The CAR Program

Purpose:

 Establishment of an innovative program for law enforcement agencies around the country to receive support through on-site embedded crime analysts as well as additional technical assistance and resources provided remotely to enhance analytical capacity and capability.

Goal:

 To more fully integrate sophisticated crime/data analysis practices, products, tools, and information into the daily operations and management of a department's violent crime and property crime reduction efforts.



The CAR Project Plan

Provide training and technical assistance to approximately 20 law enforcement agencies during the 3-year CAR Program by means of these activities:

- 1. Project kickoff and management
- 2. Identify and select sites for TTA
- 3. Provide in-residence and remote (ad hoc) TTA
- 4. Promote Subject Matter Expert engagement and peer-to-peer learning
- Coordinate with existing crime analysis associations, services, and resource providers
- 6. Identify and disseminate products and deliverables
- 7. Evaluate TTA

CAR Eligibility

- Minimal to no crime analysis capacity
- II. Persistently high or precipitous increases in crime, including violent or non-violent
- III. Ability to provide a signed Statement of Interest acknowledging senior executive (e.g., police chief or sheriff) support to establish or enhance crime analysis capacities and capabilities
- IV. Willingness to participate in a data analysis and systems capacity assessment
- V. Commitment to meet regularly with BJA and the CAR Team as determined to provide feedback and evaluations of the CAR Program.


